## The Temporal Mirror of Books 1 and 24

Book 1
Read down
Plague and corpse-burning in Akhaian camp Quarrel; Akhilleus surrenders Briseis

Thetis visits Akhilleus, who is lamenting
Akhilleus asks Thetis to appeal to Zeus
Odysseus journeys to Khryses with treasure
Thetis makes her appeal to Zeus
Quarrel among the gods

Book 24
Read up
Burning and funeral of Hektor in Troy
Reconciliation; Akhilleus returns Hektor Priam visits Akhilleus with treasure Thetis gives Zeus's command to Akhilleus Thetis visits Akhilleus, who is lamenting Zeus makes his command to Thetis Quarrel among the gods

Note: The poem was divided into twenty-four books a few centuries after it was composed, but many of the divisions correspond to breaks in the narrative. The events in books 1 and 24 are notably symmetrical.
