

By Design Installation Instructions

1. Unzip the included BD6X.ZIP file to a temporary directory of your choice.
2. Move the DISK.ID and BD30.001 files to the root of the C drive (i.e., to C:\).
3. Run the INSTALL.EXE file and follow the prompts.
4. Unzip the included BD6XFONT.ZIP file to a temporary directory of your choice.
5. Move the unzipped files to the C:\PSFONTS directory.
6. Run the BD.EXE file inside C:\WP62 (or whatever you have named the main WordPerfect directory).
7. Inside WP, press (Ctrl-F8), then press (Shift-F1), then press 9 to install the By Design fonts.
8. Press 4 (Type 1) to see all of the BD fonts that you can install. All fonts should be selected with an asterisk to the left of their names, e.g., *BD Cursif Italic. Press 2 to install the fonts, which should take very little time.
9. Once finished, exit WP and then relaunch it using BD.EXE instead of WP.EXE.
10. When you see a message about accepting the new fonts, select Y. This should occur only once.
11. Now that the fonts have been installed, the shareware version of By Design should be available to you by playing the BDREPEAT.WPM macro that has been placed in your macros directory by the installation process. (I recommend that you change this macro's name to an ALT-letter macro such as ALTD.WPM. This will make accessing the By Design menus much easier.)
12. Whenever you like, you can delete the files from the temporary directory/directories that you used for installation purposes.

Notes:

Each time, you open By Design (by running BD.EXE in step 6 above), you will be greeted by the shareware message. Simply press Enter or click OK to close that message.

There is no program manual, so you'll have to use trial and error to see how things work. The help file that comes with the program is very bare bones.

You will find either that not all of the program's functions/features are available or that they work improperly.
