

Create a One-Cell Table

I use WordPerfect to write instruction manuals in which the directions have to be emphasized so they're different from the practice problems. I tried using text boxes, but you can't edit them directly on-screen. Instead, I wrote a macro that creates a one-cell table. The advantage to working in Tables is that you can edit them on-screen. The macro is included as ALTT.WPM.

To play the macro, press (Alt-T), type your text, then press (Down Arrow) to exit the table or press (Enter) to add more lines inside the table.

Note: You can also block existing text, then play the macro. The text will be enclosed in a one-cell table.

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
