

Helpful Macros for Printing

When assigned to the Print Preview button bar, the included PRNTPG.WPM and PRNTALL.WPM macros allow you to print the current page or the entire document, respectively, from the Print Preview screen.

To assign the macros to the Print Preview button bar, press Print/Fax (Shift+F7), (7) Print Preview. Choose View, Button Bar Setup, Edit from the pull-down menu. Press (3) Add Macro, highlight PRNTPG and press (Enter) to select it. Do the same with PRNTALL. Press Exit (F7) twice to return to the document screen.

You now have two new buttons on the button bar when you are in the Print Preview screen. Click either one to do your desired printing. Both macros take you out of Print Preview, print appropriately and return to Print Preview after the print job has been sent.

*Note: You can also assign these macros as buttons on any button bar of your choice. Alternatively, you can run them without any button bar or print preview interaction by pressing (Alt-F10), typing the macro name and pressing (Enter).*
