Q: In your November '92 issue, you illustrated a macro that prompts the user to spell check a document before exiting. Personally, I believe most users spell check documents just as often before printing as before exiting. Could you please explain how to modify this macro to prompt the user to spell check before printing a document? – Rebecca S. Burleson, Signal Hill, CA

A: The included SPELLCHK.WPM macro has been requested by many of our readers. To use the macro at any time – not just when pressing Print (Shift-F7) – press Macro (Alt-F10), type “spellchk” and press (Enter).
