

Set Single Table Border Lines

I wanted to set my table borders to a single line rather than the default double line for all my tables. Here's how I did it: Press Columns/Tables (Alt+F7), (2) Tables, (1) Create. Enter the number of columns and rows you want and press (Enter). In Table Edit mode, press (6) Lines/Fill, (2) Border/Fill, (1) Border Style, highlight Single Border and press (Enter) three times. Press Exit (F7) to exit Table Edit mode. All your outside lines are now single.

The included SNGLBORD.WPM macro does all of this for you.
